

# Aesthetics Meet Draws UT Profs

Several University of Texas faculty members will present papers at an Oct. 26-30 meeting of the American Society for Aesthetics in Santa Fe, N. M. The society is expected to hold its 1968 meeting at UT.

At the Santa Fe meeting Dr. Charles Hartshorne, Ashbel Smith professor of philosophy, will present a paper on "Art Is For the Birds: The Aesthetics of Bird Song and Art Song."

Another UT philosophy professor, Dr. O. K. Bouwsma, will speak on "Poetry Becomes Truth."

Dr. Lothar Klein, composer and assistant professor of music, will survey and evaluate music since 1950 in a paper entitled "Looking Backwards."

Dr. Douglas N. Morgan, philosophy professor who is a founding member and current trustee of the American Society for Aesthetics, is program chairman for the meeting. Also attending from the university will be Dr. Arnold Salop, guest associate professor of musicology, and Samuel L. Bufford of Madison, Ga., doctoral student in philosophy.
